

Life Group Leader Agreement

Vision:

- Life Groups are connected groups of people pursuing spiritual growth together for the purpose of making disciples.
- A Life Group leader cultivates an environment for community, spiritual growth, and purpose to develop in all Life Group members.

Qualifications:

- Uphold Biblical principles to model a healthy, growing faith.
- Attend RCC regularly and be a member.
- Agree to have a background check completed.
- Have the time and desire to lead a group in pursuing spiritual growth for making disciples.

Expectations:

- Commit to praying regularly for your Life Group.
- Prepare by reviewing Life Group questions before the weekly group meeting.
- Articulate Life Group vision and continually refocus group to pursue the purpose of making disciples.
- Communicate regularly with your Life Group members. Be organized to include all necessary information in a timely manner, especially if routines change, to all group members.
- Organize care/support when needed for your group members and communicate needs to the Connections Director when appropriate.
- Cultivate shared ownership for leadership, communication, engagement, and caring of all members in the group. Create space for others to step up.
- Facilitate meaningful discussions and allow conflict with the goal of discipleship growth. Ask questions to engage multiple group members, so no one person is dominating conversation (including yourself).
- Respond to communication from Connections Director. Communicate needs/issues to Connections Director as they arise.
- Attend training sessions for Life Group leaders.
- Commit to leading a Life Group for the entire year from September through May.
