2024 has definitely been a monumental year in the life of the church. We started the year off with a new name, Rise Christian Church, which points us back to the crux of our faith, that we serve a Savior who has risen from the dead and promises us resurrected life as His followers.

Then, beginning in February we started our Together We Rise Initiative. The purpose of this initiative was to raise the spiritual tide of our church. As part of this initiative, we also were seeking to raise pledges for our building expansion project. In the middle of our campaign, we believed God was leading us to tithe on what was pledged and in the spring we announced that we would be able to expand our facilities with no debt!

In the fall, we were finally able to break ground on our building expansion project which will provide us with a new 650 seat worship center, all new children's space, a renovated café, and our existing worship center converted to much needed lobby and student ministry space.

In 2024, we have seen more people baptized, more people baptizing, more people attending church, more people connected to a Life Group, more people serving regularly, and more money given to missions than at any other point in our church history! It certainly has been exciting to see God move and to be a part of what God is doing to build His Kingdom.

Thank you to everyone who has served, given, invited, and grown in 2024, I am blessed to be a part of such an amazing church!

2024 Pastoral Care Director Annual Report

This year as the Pastoral Care Director I made home visits and encouraged others to also do home visits. I was in several area hospitals visiting and praying with people. I was able to investigate benevolent requests, and as a church we were able to help many in our community. We helped with several funerals and funeral luncheons, led a church wide Thanksgiving Basket initiative where we were able to give out close to 70 Thanksgiving baskets to area families, we had a Giving Tree this year and we were able to help 26 children with needs and wants for Christmas. The Care team continued to send cards to those grieving. We will start our 3rd session of Griefshare in January. Pastoral care connections are made at the doors on Sunday, during prayer time, through the QR codes, in Bible studies throughout the week and through Lifegroups. During staff meetings we pray over each prayer request and through the week we reach out to those on the list through a card or a personal text from one of the ministry staff. We check in on those who haven't attended in a while and try to encourage them as well. All of this and more was accomplished with several different teams of people and volunteers. 2024 Connections Director Annual Report

2024 Student Minister Annual Report

2024 has been an awesome year for the student ministry – especially from the summer onwards. This Fall has seen significant growth in middle school and high school student engagement and volunteering. Our Fall Retreat had a combined attendance of 71 students (compared to 44 last year. That's a 61% increase!) Since the retreat we've subdivided our middle school groups (now four – 6th grade boys/girls and 7th/8th grade boys/girls) and our high school girls group (9th/10th and 11th/12th). We've seen great growth despite the changes to our facilities and we're excited for the many opportunities to come with the new building soon!

2024 Highlights:

Average Attendance: 49 (combined middle and high school) - 39 in 2023

Volunteers: 6 small group leaders, 10 discussion group leaders **Baptisms:** We've had 17 student baptisms this year to date!

CIY Move – This year we took a group of 20 students (Doubling the previous year's attendance for the second year in a row!) and 4 volunteers. We also had three baptisms that took place during the trip and shortly after returning home!

This year has been so great and such a blessing for all of us on the student ministry team and we're eagerly awaiting everything God has for us in 2025. Thank you to the congregation for your support of the student ministry this year!

2024 Children's Director Annual Report

Kid's Point is flourishing, and we couldn't be more excited! We are so very blessed to have 30+ volunteers helping each month in the K-3 and 4th/5th classes.

Our K-3 class is still using GO! Curriculum and it has been awesome! Average attendance is between 55-70, weekly. The 4th/5th class continued to use Ministry to Preteens curriculum. It has gotten them deeper into the word and helped to get the conversations going. An average Sunday will see 20-25 in attendance.

All of Kid's Point is working on the books of the Bible and weekly memory verses. They earn stars from the reward jar each week by reciting the weekly verse, bringing their Bible, and/or bringing a friend. They hit 500 stars mid-year and earned an ice cream party. They are only 10 stars away from earning another 500 stars, which earns a pizza party!

Twelve 4th/5th grade students attended CIY's SuperStart in April. We had a blast learning more about Jesus, ourselves and each other! We are looking forward to attending again in March 2025!

Rise had another great year of VBS! We switched it up this year and made it a morning event. We had over 200 children in the building each day! Our Friday night family event was also a success, and so much fun!

We can't wait to see what the Lord has in store for 2025. It will be an exciting year full of growth and change and we can't wait!

RISE had a Together We Rise pledge campaign in Spring 2024. The congregation committed to \$7,922,985 in pledges. The Elders determined NO CONSTRUCTION LOAN would be needed with the commitment of the Church. We expect to raise capital of \$9,189,718 during the course of the project.

RISE contracted with Aaron Yoder Builders of Dundee, Ohio as the General Contractor. The projected expense of the project currently is \$8,356,156. We have spent \$1,565,118 as of December 31, 2024.

The Elders prayerfully considered tithing 10% of the Pledges received. Tithe amount is \$820,739 as of December 31, 2024. The Mission Team was tasked with determining the distribution with Elder approval. \$456,388 of this tithe as been sent in 2024. See Mission Team Report for details.
